Dear Parent/Guardian

I am writing to inform you of a change in Dress Code for Sixth Form, which will be effective from September 2018. The Sixth Form Student Leaders have been involved in a period of consultation, seeking input from Year 12 with regards to the appropriate dress code for the next academic year.

The students looked at options relating to uniform and business wear, and after examining the potential cost of both of these options business wear was seen to be the most favourable out of the two.

Therefore, the Dress Code for Sixth Form for the next academic year will be as follows:-

- All students must wear trousers or skirts, plain in a style suitable for school.
- Appropriate length skirts, no more than two inches above the knee.
- No leggings, jeans, combat, corduroy or tracksuit bottoms
- Shirts/blouses – no large logos or motifs.
- Students are allowed to additionally wear a tie, suit jacket or V-neck jumper over their shirt. Plain sensible business shoes leather/leatherette must be worn.
- The following items should not be worn: backless or high heeled shoes, boots, sports shoes, canvas shoes or pumps e.g. Vans
- Outer coats should be of a style suitable for school/professional environment.
- Outer coats should not be worn within the school building, apart from the Sixth Form common room.
