# Group Work Focus - Bullying

# Types of Bullying- identified by ABC's

- Cyber-bullying – social media, age sexting, grooming, fake accounts
- Apps :- snapchat, Instagram, twitter, yubo, kick, youtube, facebook, musically / tiktok
- Physical – fighting, tripping, nudging (unwanted, intentional contact)
- Verbal – spreading rumours, name calling
- Emotional
- Harassment

# Support from Anti-Bullying Champions

- Listen to them
- Re-assure them and speak calmly
- Ask if they will go and speak to an adult, if they won't ask if you can go on their behalf
- Inform adults / teachers within the support network at BT if concerned
- Drop box usage and referral forms
- Support from Pastoral team
- Talking things through (take time to do this)
- Teachers and Form Tutors to take more of an active role on combatting this
- SMSC form time to address problems, support available
- Creating a 'buddy system' from the anti-bullying champions
- Scenario role playing
